SHOW TIMES

Exhibitors MAY be at their booths on Wednesday, June 5th, and MUST be at their booths on Thursday, June 6th. Registration opens on Wednesday, June 5th, at 2:00 pm, with a session from 3:00 - 4:00 pm, and a beer garden and pitch session from 4:30 - 7:30 pm. On Thursday, June 6, registration opens at 8:00 am and the conference runs until 4:00 pm. In order to maintain the value for all conference attendees, we kindly request that exhibitors do not tear down early on Thursday.

SET UP/DEPARTURE

Exhibitors can set up their booths on Wednesday, June 5, between 8:00 am and 1:30 pm or Thurday, June 6, between 6:00-7:30 am. For those setting up on Wednesday, the space will be fully secured overnight.

The exhibit area will close down at 4:00 pm. on Thursday, June 6. Exhibitors, please begin breaking down booths around 4:00 pm on Thursday, June 6. All exhibit materials and equipment must be removed from the exhibit hall by 6:00 pm on Thursday, June 6.



EXHIBITOR SPACE

There are 20 booths available for exhibitors during Build Maine (see enclosed Exhibit Area Diagram). Standard booths are 6 ft wide by 5 ft deep.

In the tactical spirit of this event, we encourage exhibitors to consider training stations, interactive games, maker spaces, or other hands-on activities. Small equipment can be brought in and integrated into booth displays. Also, additional space may be available for particularly creative and interactive booths. Please provide us with detailed information concerning any special needs you will have for your exhibit that varies from the standard booth package.

The basic setup for each booth will include a 6 ft table, two chairs, and a standard electrical outlet with two receptacles. Exhibitors with special electrical requirements beyond the standard one outlet per booth must indicate and specify those needs when requesting exhibit space. Additional special requirements requested by the exhibitor (eg. extra tables, etc.) will be billed to the exhibitor at cost.
